The Parasol Foundation Cancer Research Program - 2022 Awards for Clinical Leadership

The Parasol Foundation Cancer Research Program Awards for Clinical Leadership is a special track designed to constitute the backbone of forthcoming medical and academic leaders of the Oncologic division. The program will enable the awardees to become proficient to hold leading clinical positions and carry out independent pioneering clinical research. A unique personalized five year program will be designed for the awardees for future development, including support for a fellowship training abroad.

About the scholarship:

A scholarship of up to \$25,000 for a minnimum of one year fellowship in leading centers abroad. The fellowship can be either research-oriented or clinical.

Eligibility and criteria:

- Oncology residents and residents in other fields related to Oncology, at the end of their first year of residency to five years after its completion, are eligible to the program.
- Priority will be given to women-physicians or fellowships related to women cancer.
- Excellence in clinical practice.
- Expected to attain a leading clinician position.
- A feasible detailed personal development plan, supported by the Department Head.

Submission rules:

The following forms should be submitted to Dr.Orly Barak until 30.6.2022 :

- CV
- A detailed personal development plan (up to two pages).
- A letter of approval and recommendation from the Department Head.
- Two recommendation letters.

The coordinator of the committee will receive all requests and as needed, will schedule a personal interview to each candidate with all members of the committee.

Candidates will be asked to present during the interview their achievements so far and a long-term personal development plan.
