

# **Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for the Supply of one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy**

Association of Friends of the Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center (“ASSOCIATION”), wishes to obtain proposals for one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning (PBS) and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy (IMPT) (the “**Facility**”), all in accordance with and subject to the terms specified in these General Terms and Conditions and the accompanying RFP Documents.

The Project described herein is a national project sponsored by the Israeli Ministry of Health (“**MOH**”) that has chosen the Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center (“**Hospital**”) to execute this project. Hospital has nominated the ASSOCIATION to carry out the project on its behalf.

For the avoidance of any doubt, ASSOCIATION, at its sole discretion, may decide to postpone any date in this RFP any number of times including Final Submission Date for any reason and/or may decide not to select any of the submitted proposals or may decide to cancel the entire RFP at any time including after the Final Submission Date and/or after the selection of the Winner Bidder, for any reason, including without limitation for lack of budget (including lack of budgetary funding from the Israeli Ministry of Health), administrative reasons or for any other reason including without cause.

## **1. Prerequisites for Participation in the RFP (the “Prerequisites”):**

- 1.1. The Bidder is the designer, manufacturer and supplier of the proposed Facility.
- 1.2. The Bidder has supplied and installed at least three (3) facilities in the last five (5) years containing at least the following:
  - Proton accelerator supporting multiple treatment rooms;
  - PBS gantry.

## **2. Proof of Compliance with the Prerequisites**

- 2.1. Bidder shall prove full compliance with the Prerequisites specified in Section 1 above, by submitting to ASSOCIATION all the details, documents and confirmations required under the provisions of the Prerequisites which shall include, inter alia, the following:
  - 2.1.1. A signed and completed statement, in the form attached hereto as Appendix D1, confirming the Bidder's full compliance with the Prerequisite set forth in Section 1.1.
  - 2.1.2. A signed and completed statement, in the form attached hereto as Appendix D1, confirming the Bidder's full compliance with the Prerequisite set forth in Section 1.2.
- 2.2. Notwithstanding the aforesaid in this Section 2.1, ASSOCIATION shall have the right, in its sole discretion, not to disqualify proposals which do not contain all the documents and certificates necessary to prove its compliance with the Pre-

requisites. ASSOCIATION shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to request from any of the bidders, details and/or approvals and/or recommendations and/or certificates and/or additional documents, necessary to enable ASSOCIATION to reach the required decisions.

- 2.3. The Bidder shall undertake to maintain its compliance with the Prerequisites specified in Section 1 above, at all times, up to and including the Proposal Validity Period as set forth below.

## **2A. JOINT AND SEVERAL OFFER**

- 2A1. Notwithstanding the above, Bidder may submit a proposal with one (1) additional entity that is Supplier's authorized representative in Israel providing that both bidders, subject to section 2(A2) below, shall undertake to jointly and severally comply with all terms of RFP, including, but not limited to, the Agreement (hereinafter: "**Joint and Several Offer**") and sign **Appendix F** by both Bidders. For the removal of any doubt, where signature is required under the terms and conditions of this RFP, then, in a Joint and Several Offer, both Bidders shall be required to sign.
- 2A2. All requirements of the RFP shall apply to Joint and Several Offer, except as follows: (1) Bidders in such offer may demonstrate compliance with the Pre-requisite in Section 1 above through one Bidder in the Joint and Several Offer. (2) Bid Guarantee and all other guarantees detailed in the Agreement may be submitted by only (1) one Bidder, provided that such Bidder is the Bidder complying with the Pre-requisite in Section 1 above. (3) The Bidder complying with the Pre-requisite in Section 2.1 above, shall be the "**Authorized Representative of the Joint and Several Offer**" as detailed in **Attachment G** - to be signed by both Bidders.

## **3. Technical Requirements**

The proposed Facility should comply with all the requirements and terms included in the technical specifications attached to the Agreement as **Appendix A** ("**Technical Specifications**").

## **4. Governing Agreement**

The supply of the Facility, including but not limited to, the price, terms of payment, scope of liability, responsibility and all other general and legal terms for the engagement with the Supplier, shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the agreement attached hereto as **Appendix C** (the "**Agreement**"). The Agreement and the appendices attached thereto constitute an inseparable part of this RFP. Each Bidder agrees to be bound by the Agreement in the event that it is chosen as the Supplier. Once the Supplier is chosen and the Agreement executed, the provisions of the Agreement shall take precedence over the provisions of this RFP in the event of a contradiction between the Agreement and this RFP.

## **5. Bid Guarantee**

- 5.1. In order to secure the due, timely and complete performance of each Bidder's obligations under its proposal, including the validity of its proposal,

ASSOCIATION shall require Bidders to submit to ASSOCIATION a bid guarantee within thirty (30) days following the receipt of such written request from ASSOCIATION (the "**Bid Guarantee Request**").

- 5.2. The bid guarantee must be an irrevocable first-class bank guarantee to the order of Association, in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Euro (500,000 Euro) currency only, valid at least up to and including 7 months from Final Submission Date. Bidder shall extend the bid guarantee if requested by ASSOCIATION.
- 5.3. Prior to submitting the Bid Guarantee, Bidders shall be entitled to present to ASSOCIATION a draft of the Bid Guarantee, for early approval.
- 5.4. It is hereby clarified that in any event that a Bidder is requested to submit a Bid Guarantee, and fails to submit such Bid Guarantee as specified in Sections 5.2 above, the Bidder shall not be entitled to further participate in this process.
- 5.5. In any event that a Bidder is requested to extend the Proposal Validity Period as defined below, the Bidder may be required to extend the term of the Bid Guarantee for the same duration of the extension of the Proposal Validity Period. ASSOCIATION shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify a proposal submitted by a Bidder who fails to extend the term of the Bid Guarantee as required herein.
- 5.6. ASSOCIATION shall be entitled, at its sole and absolute discretion, to exercise the Bid Guarantee or any part thereof, after the Bidder was given the opportunity to present its arguments, in case, *inter alia*, one of the following occurs: (1) during the RFP procedure, the Bidder acted in a misleading manner or with lack of good faith; (2) the Bidder provided misleading information (3) the Bidder retracted its proposal in the RFP after the Final Submission Date; (4) after being selected as the Winning Bidder in the RFP, the Bidder did not follow the instructions of the RFP, which are a condition for ASSOCIATION 's engagement of the Winning Bidder. The Bid Guarantee shall also serve as agreed compensation without proof of damage as defined in Section 15 of the Contracts (Remedies for Breach of Contract) Law, 1970.
- 5.7. Commencing from the Effective Date as defined in the Agreement, the Bid Guarantee furnished by the Winning Bidder for the purposes of the RFP shall secure the performance of all of the Winning Bidder's obligations under the Agreement, until replacement thereof by the Performance and Warranty Guarantee, as defined in the Agreement. Upon the receipt of the notification of being selected as the Winning Bidder, the Winning Bidder shall extend the validity of the Bid Guarantee submitted by it to ensure the continuing effect of the Bid Guarantee, until replacement thereof by the Performance and Warranty Guarantee, as defined in the Agreement.

## 6. Purchase Order

- 6.1. ASSOCIATION intends to issue a Purchase Order for the Facility (the "**Initial Purchase Order**") within sixty (60) days from the effective date of the Agreement ("**Effective Date**") subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement. For the removal of any doubt, ASSOCIATION may decide to postpone the issuance of the Initial Purchase Order for any reason, including, without limitation, (i) lack of budget (including lack of budgetary funding from the Israeli Ministry of Health), (ii) administrative reasons or (iii) any other reason including, but not limited to, without cause. Bidder waives and fully releases, exempts, discharges Association and/or the Hospital and/or any third party on their behalf (including any of their

employees, directors, officers, agents etc.) from any claim and/or liability and/or demand for any loss and/or damage (including damage to reputation) and/or expense and/or loss of profits and/or income etc. caused to Bidder and/or any third party. This is a fundamental condition of this RFP.

- 6.2. Additionally, during the Agreement Period and/or Optional Period, ASSOCIATION, in its sole discretion, shall have the option (but shall not be obligated) to purchase from the Supplier two (2) additional treatment vaults for phased installation of two (2) additional 360 degree gantries with identical PBS and IMPT capabilities ("**Optional Facility**"), all as detailed in the Agreement.

7. **Delivery Terms**

Subject to the terms of the Agreement, the terms of supply and delivery of the Facility shall be "**Delivered Duty Paid**" (DDP) (as that term is defined in Incoterms 2010, International Rules for the Interpretation of Trade, ICC Publication No. 715) at Hospital.

8. **Time of Delivery**

9. **Warranty and Maintenance for the Facility**

- 9.1. The Supplier shall provide Warranty (as defined in the Agreement) commencing on the issuance date of the Acceptance Certificate (as defined in the Agreement) and for a period of (36) months
- 9.2. As of the end of the Warranty Period and for a period of (84) months thereafter, Supplier shall provide (provided that Supplier shall fulfill all its obligations) Maintenance Services for the Facility, all as defined in the Agreement ("**Facility Initial Maintenance Period**").

- 9.3. As of the end of the Initial Maintenance Period, ASSOCIATION shall have an option, exercisable in its sole discretion, to require the Supplier to provide Maintenance Services for the Facility for a period of up to (120) months and Supplier shall provide ASSOCIATION with Maintenance Services for the Facility, all as defined in the Agreement.

## 10. **Warranty and Maintenance for the Optional Facility**

- 10.1. The Warranty Period for each Optional Facility shall be for (36) months commencing from the issuance of an Acceptance Certificate from ASSOCIATION for such Optional Facility, all as defined in the Agreement.
- 10.2. Upon the completion of the Optional Facility Warranty Period, ASSOCIATION shall purchase from Supplier Initial Maintenance Services for each Optional Facility for a period of (84) months, all as defined in the Agreement ("**Optional Facility Initial Maintenance Period**").
- 10.3. Upon the completion of the Optional Facility Initial Maintenance Period, ASSOCIATION shall have the option to purchase from Supplier Optional Maintenance Services for each Optional Facility for a period of up to 120 months, all as defined in the Agreement ("**Optional Facility Optional Maintenance Period**").

## 11. **Price Proposal**

- 11.1. The Bidder shall provide the proposed price for the supply, delivery, installation and Training (as detailed in the Agreement) Warranty of the Facility and all other Works as defined in the Agreement (the "**Proposed Price for the Initial Purchase Order**"), in the Bidder's Proposal Form attached hereto as Appendix B in accordance with the following instructions.
- 11.2. The Bidder shall provide the proposed price for the supply, installation and Warranty of the Optional Facility in the event that Association shall exercise its option to purchase Optional Facility (the "**Proposed Price for Optional Facility**"), in the Bidder's Proposal Form attached hereto as Appendix B in accordance with the following instructions.
- 11.3. The Bidder shall provide the proposed price for the Initial Maintenance for the Facility, in the Bidder's Proposal Form attached hereto as Appendix B in accordance with the following instructions (the "**Proposed Price for Initial Facility Maintenance**").
- 11.4. The Bidder shall provide the proposed price for the Optional Maintenance for Facility in the Bidder's Proposal Form attached hereto as Appendix B in accordance (the "**Proposed Price for Optional Facility Maintenance**").
- 11.5. The Initial Maintenance and/or Optional Maintenance for each Optional Facility, if purchased, shall be as detailed in Appendix B.

- 11.6. All Proposed Prices detailed in section 11.1-11.5 shall be referred to as "**Proposed Prices**").
- 11.7. All the Proposed Price shall be denominated in Euro (€) or US Dollars (US\$). In order to equally examine the proposals, the Proposed Price shall be transferred to NIS according to the representative rate of exchange published by the Bank of Association against the NIS as known on Final Submission Date.
- 11.8. The Proposed Price shall also include all taxes, fees, duties, licenses, registration fees, costs or other payments that are to be paid in connection with the exportation, supply and delivery of the Facility to ASSOCIATION at the Hospital, including, but not limited to, all types of importation and custom duties and services, such as transportation costs, customs agents' fees, purchase tax (in Hebrew "Mas Kniya" or "מס קנייה" ), wharfage fees (in Hebrew "Dmei Ratzif" or "דמי רציף" ), Israeli customs duties, port handling fees (in Hebrew "Dmei Nitul" or "דמי ניטול" ), port infrastructure fees (in Hebrew "Dmei Tashtit" or "דמי תשתית" ), locks for discharging the Facility at port, supervision while discharging at port, discharging terms at port, etc. The Price includes all applicable taxes, and ASSOCIATION shall be entitled to deduct from the Price any sum which the Israeli Tax Authorities require to be withheld at source.
- 11.9. The Contractual Price shall be the final, complete and inclusive price that will be paid to Supplier for the supply of the Facility, including all of the related services, equipment, cost, fees duties and taxes as specified in the Agreement. Supplier shall not be entitled to any other payment, fee or compensation whatsoever from ASSOCIATION.
- 11.10. Each Bidder shall solely bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid to the RFP. This shall include, without limitation, any and all expenses and losses, which may be incurred by Bidder, consultations with professionals, conducting investigations and inquiries of any kind, preparation of surveys and documents and the authentication and translation thereof and any other aspect in connection with the Bid. ASSOCIATION will in no case be responsible or liable for any of the above costs, nor shall it be required, under any circumstances, to reimburse any such costs to any Bidder.

## **12. Terms of Payment**

Payment by ASSOCIATION to the Supplier shall be as set forth in the Agreement.

## **13. Evaluation process and selection of Winning Proposal**

13.1. The evaluation of the proposals submitted by Bidders shall be conducted by ASSOCIATION in accordance with the following process:

### **13.1.1. Stage A – Preliminary Evaluation –**

13.1.1.1. **Stage A1 – Prerequisites:** Bidders will be evaluated in accordance with Section 1 above.

13.1.1.2. **Stage A2 - Technical Evaluation:** The Technical Proposals shall be evaluated in accordance with the Technical Specifications and the Technical Scoring.

13.1.2. **Stage B - Commercial Evaluation:** ASSOCIATION shall open commercial proposals of bidders who satisfy Stage A1 above and have achieved a score of at least sixty-five (65) points of the one hundred (100) points in Stage A2 above.

Nevertheless, in the event that less than two (2) Proposals shall be awarded a Weighted Technical Score of sixty-five (65) points and above in Stage A2 above, ASSOCIATION may, in its sole discretion, decide not to disqualify all or any of the Proposals awarded between fifty-five to sixty-five (55- 65) points in Stage A2 above.

13.1.3. **Stage C – Nomination of Conditional Winner:**

Conditional Winner shall be the Bidder whose proposal fully complies with the Prerequisites specified in Section 1 above and has achieved the Highest FS, as specified below ("**Conditional Winner**"). Nevertheless, it should be clarified that in the course of the evaluation process ASSOCIATION may consider additional relevant aspects, as ASSOCIATION may deem fit.

13.1.4. **Stage D - Conditional Winner's Examination:** ASSOCIATION's representatives may visit Conditional Winner's clinical and manufacturing site(s) in order to examine compliance of the Facility (approved by the association) with the Technical Specifications and the validity of Supplier's declarations in its proposal.

13.1.5. The Winning Bidder shall be the Conditional Winner that receives from ASSOCIATION a Winning Bidder's Notice, as detailed below.

13.1.6. When reviewing the proposals submitted, ASSOCIATION reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to take into consideration any negative past experience of ASSOCIATION and/or any other entity with any particular Bidder and ASSOCIATION and may reject any particular proposal based solely on such past experience.

## 14. Evaluation of Bidder's Proposal

14.1. The criteria to be used by ASSOCIATION for evaluating the proposals will include, *inter alia*, the following:

14.1.1. **(Maximum 30%)** –

14.1.1.1. Evaluation of the technical proposal is comprised of the following sub-criteria (TES Technical Evaluation Score with points):

Beam Switching time: Room to room, beam-off to beam-on	10.0
Maximum Field Size(s) for clinical operation:	10.0
Gantry Rotation Range and operation:	5.0
Range Shifter Operation: manual and automatic functionality	10.0
Beam Technical Specifications (spot specs, spot dynamics, dose rate, energy range, extraction efficiency, etc.)	10.0

Repainting Functionality (automatic volumetric, layer by layer, etc.)	10.0
Remote operations and imaging functionality (inside/outside Tx room)	6.0
Development of Future Functionality (Real-time Adaptive Therapy, Flash, Arc Tx) and upgrades are included in service/maintenance contract	10.0
Ease of Access to patient while on Tx couch (ie, can therapists move easily around pt., anesthesiologist work/equip comfortably)	10.0
Aesthetics of Tx room and gantry appearance (does nozzle feel clinical or industrial, intimidating or comforting, etc. Loudness of system in Tx room (ie, dB background noise)	5.0
Uptime Guarantee	5.0
Power Consumption:	5.0
Hours of Clinical Availability:	4.0

14.1.1.2. ASSOCIATION shall have the right, at its sole and absolute discretion, to disqualify a Bid that has been awarded less than sixty-five (65) points of the one hundred (100) points allocable under this Section 11 and in the event of a single offer in the RFP – if such offer receives less than eighty (80) points of the above one hundred.

14.1.1.3. Nevertheless, in the event that less than two (2) Proposals shall be awarded a Weighted Technical Score of sixty-five (65) points and above, ASSOCIATION may, at its sole discretion, decide not to disqualify all or any of the Proposals awarded between fifty-five to sixty-five (55-65) points.

14.1.1.4. Subject to ASSOCIATION's discretion, the points will be awarded on a comparative and proportional basis.

14.1.1.5. After the Total Point (TP) is determined, the TES (Technical Evaluation Scoring) will be calculated pursuant to the following formula:

$$TES = TP * 0.3$$

14.1.2. **Commercial Evaluation** (Maximum **70%**) calculated as follows:

(a) After the Proposal Evaluation Price is determined, the **Commercial Evaluation Scoring (“CES”)** will be calculated, pursuant to the following formula:

$$CES = \frac{LPEP * 70}{BPEP}$$

**Where:**

**CES** – Bidder’s Commercial Evaluation Scoring

**LPEP** – Lowest Proposal Evaluation Price of all valid proposals, calculated as per subsection (a) above

**BPEP** – the specific Proposal Evaluation Price of the Bidder, calculated as per subsection (a) above.

## 15. Selection of the Winner Bidder

The winning proposal shall be the proposal that obtained, the highest **Final Scoring** ("FS"), which shall be calculated as follows:

$$\text{FS} = \text{CES} + \text{TES}$$

**Where:**

**FS** – Final Scoring

**CES** – Commercial Evaluation Scoring, calculated pursuant to Section 11.1.2.

**TES** – Technical Evaluation Scoring, calculated as a total of points received in all of the evaluation criteria set out in Section 14.1.1.

## 16. Conditional Winner's Examination

- 16.1. Within two (2) weeks from ASSOCIATION's notice to Winner that it has been selected as the Conditional Winner ("**Conditional Winner Notification**"), arrangements shall be made in order to enable ASSOCIATION's Representatives to visit Conditional Winner's site or other location where the clinical site/manufacture site Facility is located to confirm Conditional Winner's ability to comply with its undertakings and validate its warranties in its proposal in the RFP and/or ask to receive any additional information (including data on the uptime) in order comply with its undertakings and validate its warranties in its proposal in the RFP.
- 16.2. For the avoidance of any doubt, **only** in the event that ASSOCIATION's Representative shall confirm Conditional Winner's ability to comply with its undertakings in its proposal in the RFP, ASSOCIATION shall issue a notice to the Conditional Winner with respect to its selection as the Winning Bidder ("**Winning Bidder Notice**").
- 16.3. In the event ASSOCIATION shall have reasonable doubt as to the validity and accuracy of Conditional Winner's declarations and/or its ability to comply with its undertakings and/or in the event that Conditional Winner, then ASSOCIATION shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to withdraw the status awarded to the Conditional Winner and to choose the Bidder which has the next higher scored proposal after the Conditional Winner as the Conditional Winner.
- 16.4. Nothing detailed above shall derogate from ASSOCIATION's right to perform inspections as detailed in the Agreement.
- 16.5. Without derogating from the above, in the event that within 60 (sixty) days from the Conditional Winner Notification, ASSOCIATION shall not issue a Winning Bidder Notice for any reason, the ASSOCIATION shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to withdraw the status awarded to the Conditional Winner and to choose the Bidder which has the next lowest price proposal after the Conditional Winner as the new Conditional Winner.
- 16.6. ASSOCIATION shall have the right to extend the time periods in Sections 16.1 and/or Section 16.5 upon its sole discretion.

## 17. Submission of Proposals

- 17.1. All proposals must be submitted no later than **14.12 ,2020 by 13:00 (Israeli time)** ("**Final Submission Date**") in three separate envelopes, as specified below, and these shall all be inserted into one main envelope, which shall read "RFP for the Supply of one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy - Facility " (the "**Main Envelope**") at the address set below. ASSOCIATION shall be entitled to postpone the deadline at its sole discretion.
- 17.2. The proposal shall be submitted by a single bidder. Proposals submitted by more than one bidder will be disqualified.
- 17.3. The proposal is to be submitted in 3 copies into RFP Box located at the following address:
- Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Old Building, 6 Witzman St., Tel Aviv.
- One copy shall be an original copy and the other ones shall be copies of the original. In case of any inconsistency the original copy shall prevail. The original copy shall be marked "**Original**".
- 17.4. The Bidder is requested to read carefully all of the documents attached herein and submit the following documents which should be included in the Main Envelope, signed, where applicable, by the authorized signatory bodies.
- 17.5. An envelope which shall read "**Commercial Proposal** –RFP for the Supply of one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy - Facility\_" shall be inserted in the Main Envelope and shall include the following:
- 17.6. A signed and completed Bidder's Proposal Form (**Appendix B**).
- 17.7. A separate envelope which shall read "**Prerequisites** - RFP for the Supply of one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy - Facility" shall be inserted in the Main Envelope and shall include the following:
- 17.7.1. A signature on the last page of the Agreement (**Appendix C**), including the Bidder's relevant information in the heading thereof (excluding the date) and including the Bank Account Form, attached to the Agreement as **Appendix C** (**only the winning Bidder shall be required to complete part B of the Bank Account Form**).
- 17.7.2. A signed and completed statement, in the form attached hereto as **Appendix D1**, confirming the Bidder's full compliance with the Prerequisite set forth in Section 1.1.

**AND**

- 17.7.3. A signed and completed statement, in the form attached hereto as **Appendix D2**, confirming the Bidder's full compliance with the Prerequisite set forth in Section 1.2.
- 17.8. A separate envelope which shall read "**Technical Proposal** – RFP for the Supply of one (1) proton accelerator, either cyclotron or synchrotron, and two (2) 360 degree rotating gantries, capable of Pencil Beam Scanning and Intensity Modulated Proton Therapy - Facility" shall be inserted in the Main Envelope and shall include the following technical information:
- 17.8.1. A signed copy of the Technical Specifications (**Appendix A**).
  - 17.8.2. A signed copy of the Technical Declaration (**Appendix A1**).
  - 17.8.3. Company profile of the Bidder and relevant information and data regarding the Facility.
  - 17.8.4. Any and all drawings, certifications, documentation, information and instructions required pursuant to the Technical Specifications.
  - 17.8.5. All information listed in **Appendix E** including but not limited the estimation of Hospital Works, as defined in the Agreement.
- 17.9. The Bidder shall also include a full history of the Facility proposed, including extraordinary events, such as accidents in which the Facility proposed was involved.
- 17.10. All information shall be submitted also in a soft copy (PDF file on USB drive).
- 17.11. ASSOCIATION, at its sole discretion, may decide to postpone any date in this RFP any number of times including Final Submission Date for any reason, including, without limitation, (i) lack of budget (including lack of budgetary funding from the Israeli Ministry of Health), (ii) administrative reasons, or (iii) any other reason including, but not limited to, without cause. Bidder waives and fully releases, exempts, discharges Association and/or the Hospital and/or any third party on their behalf (including any of their employees, directors, officers, agents etc.) from any claim and/or liability and/or demand for any loss and/or damage (including damage to reputation) and/or expense and/or loss of profits and/or income etc. caused to Bidder and/or any third party. This is a fundamental condition of this RFP.

**18. Request for clarifications and/or additional information**

- 18.1. Any Bidder may submit to ASSOCIATION in writing, inquiries and/or requests for clarification and/or additional information regarding the RFP or relating to the RFP Documents, as specified herein below (a "**Request for Clarification**").
- 18.2. A Request for Clarification shall be titled "**Request for Clarification**" and shall clearly specify to which RFP Documents (volume, attachment, section) it refers.
- 18.3. Bidders shall submit Requests for Clarification with respect to any errors, ambiguities, inconsistencies, omissions, erroneous, unclear or imperfect provisions ("**Errors**") in the RFP Documents. It is clarified that by submitting its Bid, Bidder irrevocably and unconditionally waives any claim, demand or legal or

administrative proceeding alleging or claiming that the selection process in the RFP has been influenced or biased by an Error and/or that Bidder has suffered any damages as a result of such Error.

## 20. **Proposal Validity**

All submitted proposals must be valid for at least six (6) months from the Final Submission Date as set forth above (the "**Proposal Validity Period**"), and may not be revoked or changed by the Bidder during this period for any reason whatsoever. In the event that ASSOCIATION shall not enter into a contractual relationship with the winning Bidder, for any reason whatsoever, and/or the agreement with the winning Bidder will be cancelled, ASSOCIATION shall be entitled to elect, as a winning proposal, the proposal which achieved the next highest FS. The terms set forth in this Section shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, following the replacement of the Bidder's proposal as aforesaid.

## 21. **Verification**

ASSOCIATION shall have the right, at its sole and absolute discretion, to verify the documents provided by the Bidder, and to request from any of the Bidders additional details, approvals, recommendations and/or certificates. In addition, ASSOCIATION may, at its sole and absolute discretion, upon prior coordination with the Bidder, inspect the facilities of such Bidder at any time or any facilities where the Facility proposed by the Bidders are being maintained and/or refurbished.

## 22. **Negotiations**

- 22.1. ASSOCIATION reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to conduct negotiations with any of the Bidders in this RFP that it finds suitable, with respect to their commercial and/or technical proposal, or not to conduct negotiations at all.

ASSOCIATION is not required to carry out such negotiations equally with all Bidders and such negotiations may pertain to any matter in the discretion of ASSOCIATION. As part of such negotiations, ASSOCIATION may request that Bidders improve or change their offers.

- 22.2. Without derogating from the above, ASSOCIATION shall have the right to instruct all Bidders whose Commercial Proposals were evaluated, to submit an additional improved Commercial Proposal in the event that all proposals received are less favorable to ASSOCIATION than the ASSOCIATION estimation and/or to cancel the RFP. Bidders hereby forfeit any claim in the event that ASSOCIATION shall decide to act in such manner.

### 23. Language of Proposals

All documents submitted by the Bidder in this RFP (including, but not limited to, all attachments, schedules, Appendixes, sketches, drawings, diagrams, tables and charts) and any additional information, question, request for clarification and interpretation, or any other communication, must be in English only, unless otherwise specifically stated in the RFP Documents or approved by ASSOCIATION.

### 24. Confidentiality and Proprietary Rights

- 24.1. By participating in the RFP process, each purchaser of the RFP Documents and each Bidder are deemed to have agreed to keep in strict confidence, and not to disclose and/or to make any use of any information or data, or any form or media, partial or complete, provided to them by ASSOCIATION on its behalf or made known to them otherwise as a result of or in connection with the RFP; except that each Bidder may use such information or data solely for the purpose of preparing its bid. It is hereby clarified that this section shall not apply to documents and/or information published by ASSOCIATION on its website.
- 24.2. By submitting a bid, each Bidder (including its members) shall be deemed to represent and warrant to ASSOCIATION that (i) it is not bound by any contractual or statutory obligations which would preclude the Bidder from providing the data and information contained in the bid or any portion thereof; (ii) it has the right to make all disclosures that are made in the bid; (iii) the data and information contained in the bid do not include any confidential information, trade secret or other proprietary information of the bidder and/or any third party (except as and to the extent that the bidder may otherwise clearly indicate in writing) which ASSOCIATION is prevented from using.

- 25.6. Israeli law shall be the governing law of this RFP and the competent courts in Tel Aviv, Israel shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute concerning this RFP.
- 25.7. The issuance by ASSOCIATION of a Purchase Order under the Agreement shall be following the receipt of the necessary budgetary approvals including receiving budgetary funding from the Israeli Ministry of Health.
- 25.8. ASSOCIATION, at its sole discretion, may decide not to select any of the submitted proposals or may decide to cancel the entire RFP at any time including after the Final Submission Date and/or after the selection of the Winner Bidder, for any reason, including without limitation for (i) lack of budget, (ii) administrative reasons, or (iii) any other reason including, without limitation, without cause. Bidder waives and fully releases, exempts, discharges Association and/or the Hospital and/or any third party on their behalf (including any of their employees, directors, officers, agents etc.) from any claim and/or liability and/or demand for any loss and/or damage (including damage to reputation) and/or expense and/or loss of profits and/or income etc. caused to Bidder and/or any third party. This is a fundamental condition of this RFP.
- 25.9. ASSOCIATION reserves the right to reject a proposal of a Bidder whose commercial Proposal is lower and/or higher than ASSOCIATION's estimation.

25.10. In addition to any other event which entitles ASSOCIATION by law to cancel the RFP, ASSOCIATION reserves the right, in ASSOCIATION's sole discretion, to cancel this RFP in the following events:

25.10.1. If only one of the proposals is found suitable, according to the Prerequisites and/or other specification requirements according to this RFP Documents;

25.10.3. If ASSOCIATION has found that a mistake has been made in the Technical Specifications, inter alia, by giving false data, missing data or incomplete data;
