Research Objectives: Our Lab deals with pathogenic fungi that cause life-threatening infections in humans, mostly immunosuppressed individuals. We aim to characterize mechanisms of virulence and invasion, as well as novel determinants of resistance to antifungal drugs. Our work combines "wet" mycology, clinical and epidemiological research, with genomic tools, population analysis, cell cultures and animal models of fungal infection.

Main Research topics:

- Hetero resistance in the pathogenic yeast Candida glabrata
- Angioinvasiveness and modulation of angiogenesis by Aspergillus fumigatus
- Epidemiology of invasive mold infections and antifungal resistanceamong pathogenic molds in Israel a prospective national survey
